Transport options

Venue

- Collective bus transport at 07:30 from Brussels (Avenue de la Renaissance n°30) to the event venue. Please be there on time as the bus has a tight schedule.
- Shuttle from the Tournai railway station (https://www.belgiantrain.be/en) to the event venue. We kindly ask you to indicate your train's arrival time in the registration system.
- By car (parking Square Bonduelle): further information will be provided close to the seminar date.

Departure

- Collective bus transport from the event venue at 20:15, <u>after the walking dinner</u>, to Brussels (Avenue de la Renaissance n°30).
- Shuttle from the event venue to the Tournai railway station (https://www.belgiantrain.be/en) after the walking dinner.

7. Accommodation

Please note that accommodation is at the discretion of the participants.

8. Social-Cultural activity

Two options (both offered in French, Dutch and English)

- Mini UNESCO tour (Notre-Dame Cathedral): a guide will explain the hidden secrets of two of the town's must-see sites: the majestic Notre-Dame Cathedral and the oldest belfry in Belgium. These two sites shape Tournai's landscape and can be seen from dozens of kilometers away. On this tour, you'll learn all about the unique history of these two jewels. Please note that this activity is subject to change depending on weather conditions.
- Guided tour in the Museum des Beaux-Arts (Musée des Beaux-Arts de Tournai): the Museum is the only building in Wallonia designed by the Art Nouveau architectural genius Victor Horta. Its original tortoise-shaped configuration dates from 1928 and is an interesting example of the transition between Art Nouveau and Art Deco-inspired modernism. The building is one of the very first so-called "modern" museums in the world, and well worth a visit!

Please be informed that the city of Tournai is covered with **cobblestones**. We would recommend appropriate footwear.



9. Walking dinner

10. Public health measures in the Town Hall (Tournai)
